Marshall) (1925), The Sermon on the Mount (1931), Saw John Seeks the Solution of His Preaching Problems (1932), On the Threshold of the Century: An Historical Sketch of the Karen Mission 1828-1928 and the Burma Annual for 1928 (with Emma W. Marshall) (1929), Devadoss and His Preaching Problems (1932), The Karens of Burma (1945) and Flashes Along the Burma Road (1946).
